Re: 2008-09 Auto Insurance Pass-Through Rates

Effective with the November 2008 Fleet billing (to be processed on December 1, 2008), the Physical Damage portion of the auto insurance pass-through rates will be increased by approximately 222%. The increase is due to system-wide program trends which include increases in the claim frequency (number of claims) and claim severity (cost of repairs) and is consistent with costs allocated to the campus from UCOP for 2008-09.

Each year auto insurance rates are reviewed and modified by Risk Management Services based on system-wide premium costs and loss experience. Please refer to the table below for detailed monthly rates for the size of vehicle(s) you lease from Fleet Services.

The 2008-09 Auto Liability rates have not yet been announced, therefore, no change is forthcoming at this time. Fleet Services will continue to pass-through liability rates based on 2007-08 premiums until we receive new rate information from ORMP.
