

Un-Acceptable Vehicle Fair Wear and Tear

◆ Interior

Seating

- Any staining that permanently damages the texture of the seat.
- Cuts, rips, or tears.
- Burns.
- Any damage to seat structures.

Dashboard, Fascia, Trim

- Moderate heavy scratches over 4 inches in length.
- Multiple scratches under 4 inches in length which can be felt as well as seen.
- Cuts, dents and tears.
- Burns.
- Permanent staining.
- Holes from add-on equipment.
- Door trim missing.
- Knobs or controls missing.

Floor

- Excessive wear to the floor.
- Excessive staining of materials.
- Burns.
- Holes or tears.

◆ Exterior

Side Panels, Doors, Roofs

- Any dent that is visible on the exterior.
- Paneling that is bent or misshapen.

Load Area, Floors, and Bulkhead

- Dents that have changed the overall shape of paneling.
- Any piercing of interior panels.
- Paneling that bent or deformed.
- Excessive substance residue which cannot be removed.
- Cracking to body.

Cab

- Scratches that penetrate to bare metal or primer.
- Excessive scratching in localized area.
- Dents over 1 inch in diameter.
- Multiple minor dents.
- Minor dent that has broken through the paint.
- Damage from accessory/sign removal.

Bumpers

- Any bumper that is incomplete, cracked, twisted or mis-aligned.
- Any dent over 4 inches.

Chassis

- Any significant damage.
- Undercarriage damage.
- Modification without authorization.
- Cracking.
- Any bent or twisted chassis rail.

Glass, Lamps, Mirrors

- Any damage that would cause heating element failure on rear window.

- Any hole, or crack in a lamp lens.
- Any damage to mirror glass.

Accessories, Signs

- Any unauthorized signage.
- Damage caused by fitted accessories.
- Holes due to fitted accessories.
- Any damage were signs have been removed.

Wheels, Tires, Guards and Tools

- Any significant damage to the rim or wheel.
- Missing wheel tools and jack.
- Damage to tire sidewall.

◆ Bodies and Ancillary Equipment

Trays, Dropsides, Tailgates & Hoist

- Any damage were body work is pierced.
- Drop side or tailgates that will not open and close without undue force or cannot be closed securely.
- Body work distortions.
- Holes.
- Damaged tailgates.

Bodywork excluding the Cab

- Large dents.
- Damage that allows water to penetrate the vehicle load area.
- Sliding doors too badly damaged to close properly.

Tail-lift Platforms, Winches

- Tail-lifts must not be bent or distorted.

Floor

- Floors that have large dents or holes, missing or broken floorboards are unacceptable.

Shutters, Doors, excluding Cab

- Door hardware that is broken. (locks, hinges etc.)

Ancillary Equipment

- Any equipment that is damaged or cannot be operated correctly.

Turn Tables

- Damage to locking pins.
- Missing mounting bolts.

Fuel Tanks, Exhaust Stakes and Walkways

- Multiple dents in fuel tank.
- Pierced fuel tank.
- Damaged straps.
- Broken or damaged exhaust stakes.
- Missing or broken cab steps.
